<b>Language Requirement</b>	Good command over English. No official test is required for students of partner Universities
<b>Course enrolment</b>	Final course registration will be done in the first two days of the program. All exchange students will have access to the PGDM courses. Time table will be available on the institute's intranet.
<b>Credits</b>	The normal workload in a semester is 21 credits. A three (3) credit classroom based course will comprise of 30 classroom sessions of ninety minutes each. This amounts to 45 hours of instructor assisted learning. In addition to this, the course requires a minimum of 90 hours of self-learning for class assignments and projects.
<b>Exams</b>	Exchange students are required to stay until the end if the scheduled exams as mentioned in the academic calendar.
<b>Grading</b>	Grading scales goes from 0 to 10, the lowest passing grade being 5.

<b>Accommodation</b>	The institute will provide compulsory residential facilities on its premises. Separate hostels for men and women. Students are not required to look for off campus accommodation. However, the students would have to pay the amount as per the IMT Hyderabad rules. Details of which are given below.
<b>Approximate Expenses (per Semester)</b>	Housing and Food is provided on the IMT Hyderabad campus to all foreign students. A compulsory fee of INR 50,000 is payable by foreign students at the International Relations Office. This fee must be paid in cash, within 15 days of arrival on campus.
<b>Academic Expenses</b>	No tuition fees. You may choose to stay for a semester or even for a year.
<b>Meal Plan</b>	The student's hostel has a mess within the campus which provides four meals a day for all the students at IMT Hyderabad. The campus also has an excellent canteen and cafeteria where a variety of food and beverages are available round the clock.
<b>Medical Facilities</b>	A visiting doctor is available on the campus from 5:30 PM–6:30 PM every day. The doctor provides the prescription, however the medicines and the prescribed medical tests have to be taken care of by the students.
<b>Visa Requirements</b>	It is mandatory for all exchange students to come to IMT Hyderabad on a student visa. IMT Hyderabad will send a letter of admission as soon as the nominations are received from the respective institute and it will be the responsibility of the incoming exchange students to comply with any Visa or other regulatory requirements.
<b>Pick – up assistance upon Arrival</b>	The International Relations Center will arrange for free pick up of the exchange students for the first time at the Rajiv Gandhi
