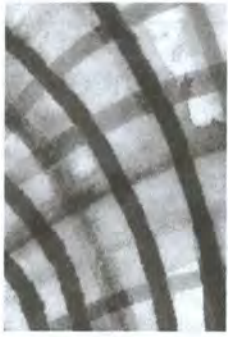

- 247** **North Carolina Water Utility Builds Resilience with Distributed Energy Resources**
Kate Anderson, James Grymes, Alexandra Newman, Adam Warren
As the frequency and duration of grid outages increase, backup power systems are becoming more important for ensuring that critical infrastructure continues to provide essential services. A mixed-integer linear program minimizes costs and maximizes resilience at a wastewater treatment plant in Wilmington, North Carolina. We find that the plant can reduce life-cycle energy costs by 3.1% through the installation of a hybrid combined-heat-and-power, photovoltaic, and storage system.
- 266** **Algorithm for Robotic Picking in Amazon Fulfillment Centers Enables Humans and Robots to Work Together Effectively**
Russell Allgor, Tolga Cezik, Daniel Chen
This paper describes how Amazon redesigned the robotic picking algorithm used in Amazon Robotics (AR) fulfillment centers (FCs) to enable humans and robots to work together effectively. In AR FCs, robotic drives fetch storage pods filled with inventory for associates to pick, and the picking algorithm decides which specific units of inventory on which pods should be picked to fulfill customer order shipments. This new algorithm reduced the number of drives required in AR FCs by 31% without negative operational impact and has since been implemented in all AR FCs, amounting to half a billion dollars in savings.
- 283** **Information Value Analysis for Real-Time Silo Fill-Level Monitoring**

- 295** **Rationalized Timetabling Using a Simulation Tool: A Paradigm Shift in Indian Railways**

This paper focuses on the challenges and the managerial and human aspects of the rationalized timetabling exercise undertaken by Indian Railways in 2020. For the first time, a simulation software tool was used to generate the timetable on the six principal routes of Indian Railways, known as the golden quadrilateral + diagonals. The paper also explains how this project leverages the benefits of combining top-down and bottom-up approaches in timetabling and how it sets a new paradigm for network-wide timetabling in Indian Railways.

Gold Is Old: Noble Metal in the Indian Economy Through Ages
Satish Deodhar

175

Abstract: Indians have had a fascination for possessing gold since ancient times. I document the sacredness of gold, ancient references to jewellery, gold extraction and minting technology, its function as money and store of value, and specie inflow due to trade surplus with the Occident until the medieval era. India's gargantuan stock of about 28,000 tonnes of gold is hoarding and not savings. Today, gold demand is causing a leakage from the circular flow of gross domestic product (GDP) and trade deficit. Policy suggestions are made that will re-channel idle excess stock of gold into financial markets, reduce the trade deficit, and contribute to GDP growth.

Abstract: The study attempted to understand the relationship between various constructs like mindfulness, experiential avoidance, depression, anxiety, and stress, amongst university-level undergraduate and postgraduate students. We used scales from existing literature to study the constructs among students. The study found that mindfulness is significantly and negatively associated with experiential avoidance and depression; all three are intercorrelated. With regression analysis, we found that acceptance mediates between mindfulness and depression, anxiety, and stress amongst undergraduate and postgraduate students. The results explain that students who have high acceptance are more mindful, use less avoidant strategies, and hence are less depressed compared to students who have low acceptance and are less mindful, display negative moods and experience more depression.

Rani Kamplapati (Habibganj) Railway Station Redevelopment: A World-Class Dream Coming True

Abstract: In 2016, Indian Railways awarded a ₹4.5 billion contract for a public-private partnership project to redevelop Rani Kamplapati (Habibganj) Railway Station. A year later, the concessionaire submitted a ₹0.4 billion proposal, requesting a modification to the mandatory part of the project, i.e. permission to add a podium on the station frontage, to improve its public and commercial value. This modification was to come at no cost to railways. The concessionaire also sought permission for commercial redevelopment of an additional 26,000 sqm. In June 2018, the concessionaire withdrew the proposal for adding the podium while proceeding with the additional commercial redevelopment.
