## **TRAVEL AND ACCOMODATION**

Delhi is said to be one of the oldest existing cities in the world. Legend estimates it to be over 5,000 years old. The population of Delhi is a heterogeneous mix of people belonging to different parts of India. In winter, especially December and January, Delhi is cold, but quite comfortable when compared to the severe cold in most parts of Europe, North America and South America. It has a rich heritage and places of tourist interest abound in and nearby areas of Delhi, including the famous Taj at Agra.

Indira Gandhi International Airport Terminal 3 is the arrival point for most international visitors into Delhi. The airport has been extensively revamped and transformed into a thoroughly modern facility equivalent to the best airports in the world. Domestic flights operate from this Terminal as well as from Terminal 1D, typically used by low-cost carriers. A free shuttle bus operates between the two every 20 min. The Delhi Airport Metro Express (DAME) is a Delhi Metro train line passing through the airport, and its operating timings are from 5AM-11PM every 20 minutes. Radio Taxis are readily available at the arrival terminals which charge a per kilometer rate after dropping you at the destination and give you a printed receipt. Alternatively, you can pay for a taxi at the prepaid taxi booths run by Delhi Police in the airport terminal. When leaving Delhi from the international terminal, you should show up three hours before your flight is scheduled as security is tight. Currency changing facilities are available at the Airport Terminal and various other outlets in the city. If you wish to change Rupees back into foreign currency, you must do this before clearing security.

Over 400 Hotels in all star ratings and budget categories are available in New Delhi. Excursion tours to Taj and other places of tourist interest are available through most of the on-line hotel and tour service providers.
